

After-School Bowling Program FAQs

We offer a safe and reliable after-school program, from the time they exit their classroom until 5:30 p.m. All leaders are CPR/First Aid certified and experienced in coaching, tutoring, game leading, and crafts.

When does the program begin? The After-School Program operates once a week for a 10-week session. Each school will participate in one session (Fall, Winter, or Spring) per the school schedule.

When is the deadline? All students participating in the After-School Program must be registered in order to be picked-up by our bus immediately after school on the date scheduled for your school. Please return the registration form to the school office or the bowling centers as soon as possible so that your child will be registered. Students are permitted to join the program after the first week if spots are still available. Places are given on a first come, first serve basis. Students cannot participate until registered.

Payments: The price per day is \$10.00 and will include transportation to bowling center, cost of bowling, and rental shoes. Checks should be made payable to Beaver-Vu Bowl or Pla-Mor Lanes. There will be a \$40 fee for returned checks. No checks will be accepted on the last day of bowling. Payments are due by the regularly scheduled day your child attends the center on the week of service. You may pay monthly or for the full term if you prefer to do so. Parents are allowed to pay upon child pick-up. Failure to pick-up the child within the time frame will result in an additional charge of ten dollars for each half-hour (or any portion thereof) for child supervision services.

Missed Days, Early Dismissals, and School Closings: The After-School Bowling Program does not issue refunds for missed days. If your child misses his or her scheduled day, payment will be forwarded to the next scheduled day's invoice. In case of an early dismissal, the After-School Bowling Program will start at the time of school dismissal until the regular ending time. In the case of an early dismissal due to extreme weather conditions there will be no bowling. There will be no bowling on days when there is no school, including days that the School District closes because of extreme weather conditions.

Why isn't my school listed as participating? Those schools that were selected to participate in this program were selected because of their proximity and willingness of school administration to offer the program. We do plan to expand the program in the future. If you would like to see your school collaborating with Beaver-Vu Bowl or Pla-Mor Lanes in the future, we suggest that you let officials at your school know that you are interested in this program. They can contact management at Beaver-Vu Bowl or Pla-Mor Lanes to obtain further information.

Own your own bowling shoes and ball; locker rental special: The After-School Bowling Program is running a special for the students participating in the program to buy their very own bowling shoes and ball. Payments can be made in a lay-a-way option or be paid in full. Students are able to rent lockers at their designated bowling center (based on availability) during the 10 week session.
