Midwest USA Adult-Junior Doubles Championships Rules

This is a USBC certified scratch doubles bowling tournament. The tournament will be held on **Saturday, April 3, 2010** at Beaver-Vu Bowl, 1238 N. Fairfield Rd., Beavercreek, OH 45432. 937.426.6771. Check-in begins at 9:00 AM. Warm-ups at 9:45 AM. Tournament play begins about 10:00 AM Eastern time. Every bowler must be a 2009-2010 season USBC member. A team will consist of one adult bowler and one youth bowler. There are two divisions: a division for an adult bowler teamed with a youth bowler age 14-19 and a separate division for an adult bowler teamed with a youth bowler age 13 and under. The youth bowler's age on August 1, 2009 will be the determiner of division enrollment. The gender of either the adult or the youth bowler is NOT a consideration. A male may team & bowl with a male or female, or vice versa.

Format: The format is the same in both divisions. **Qualifying Round:** Each team will bowl a Qualifying Round of four (4) games of regular tenpin bowling. Approximately 50% of the field will advance to the Championship Round based on the team score in the Qualifying Round. **Championship Round:** The scores from the Qualifying Round will be dropped. All Championship Round games will be Baker games in which the youth bowler will bowl the even numbered frames and the adult bowler the odd numbered frames. Each advancing team will bowl two (2) "Baker" games with each game bowled entirely on 1 lane, switching lanes on the pair after each game. The field will be cut in half after each 2 Baker game set based on the team's 2 game Baker total. This elimination format will be repeated until the field is down to the final 2 or 3 teams which will be final 2-game Baker set. **Championship Round Placement:** In both divisions, higher placement in the final tournament standings will be awarded to the higher-seeded losing team.

Cost: The pre-paid (received on or before Friday, 4.2.10) entry fee is \$70.00 per team. Breakdown: Cost of bowling: \$25.00. Tournament expenses: \$5.00. SMART scholarships for youth bowlers: \$40.00. Total pre-paid entry fee: \$70.00. **Note: day of tournament walk-in entries will be charged an additional \$10.00 late processing fee.** The closing date for entries is Saturday, April 3, 2010. *Only paid entries will be accepted.*

General Rules: No jeans, hats, or non-medical headgear. Abuse of equipment, foul or disruptive language, gestures, and/or unprofessional behavior by bowlers or spectators are cause for the non-refundable dismissal from participation or attendance at this tournament. All bowling equipment must meet USBC specifications. The use of powder or any foreign substance (including Easy Slide) on shoes, the approach, or on the facility floor or carpet is not permitted. Only participating bowlers and officials are permitted in the bowling area. The Tournament Manager has the right to refuse any entry. The bowler, by voluntary participation in the event, acquiesces to the final authority of the Tournament Manager to interpret and enforce all rules, regulations, and procedures. Any unforeseen or not described situation(s) will be regulated by USBC rules with interpretative judgment guided by the best interest of youth bowling and this event. USBC Rule 400 will be observed.

Awards: The youth bowler on no fewer than one of seven teams (1:7) will be awarded a SMART scholarship. Any sponsor or additional scholarship revenue collected from non-entry fee sources will be divided equally between divisions. 100% of all collected scholarship funds for youth bowlers will be awarded and sent to the SMART Program for management and dispersal (Acct. #8871).
